- We employ 190 people and hired 8 new graduate nurses from our community

- Homebound patients requiring skilled services such as nursing, physical/occupational/speech therapy, medical social worker, & certified nurse aides.

Hospice

- Terminal illness with expected prognosis 6 months or less verified by two providers. Nursing care, therapists if warranted, medical social worker up to 12 months of bereavement.

- Intensive outpatient Behavioral Health Program for Senior Adults. Transportation provided if needed
