 - Bullock Avenue from Lopezville Road to California Street,
 - College Avenue from Leroy Place to California Street,
 - Franklin Avenue from College Avenue to School of Mines Road.
 - El Camino Real from College Avenue to Bullock Avenue,

Within the control of the City of Socorro, in Socorro County, New Mexico.


