RESOLUTION NO. 21-11-15a
LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE NEW MEXICO
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the **City of Socorro** and the New Mexico Department of Transportation has entered into a Cooperative Agreement;

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be **\$500,000.00** to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 100% or **\$500,000.00**
- b. The **City of Socorro** proportional matching share shall be 0%;

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS **\$500,000.00**

The **City of Socorro** shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of **\$500,000.00**

Now therefore, be it resolved that, the **City of Socorro** determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

- a. That the project for this Cooperative Agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.
- b. The agreement terminates on June 30, 2022 and the **City of Socorro** incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings have been merged in the written agreement.
- c. The **City of Socorro** has entered into Cooperative Agreement CN LM700028 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for Fiscal Year 2022 for the roadway and utility improvements, drainage improvements, shoulder improvements, landscaping, lighting, construction management, and miscellaneous, to

- Bullock Avenue from Lopezville Road to California Street,
- College Avenue from Leroy Place to California Street,
- Francisco de Avondo from El Camino Real to California Street,
- El Camino Real from College Avenue to Bullock Avenue,

Within the control of the **City of Socorro**, in Socorro County, New Mexico.
