**LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE NEW MEXICO
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Socorro and the New Mexico Department of Transportation has entered into a Cooperative Agreement;

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be **\$330,372** to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or **\$247,779**
- b. The City of Socorro proportional matching share shall be 25% or **\$82,593**

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS **\$330,372**

The City of Socorro shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of **\$330,372**

Now therefore, be it resolved that, the City of Socorro determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

- a. That the project for this Cooperative Agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.
- b. The agreement terminates on June 30, 2023 and the City of Socorro incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings have been merged in the written agreement.
- c. The City of Socorro has entered into Cooperative Agreement CN L100519 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project Year 2022 for the Planning, Design, Construction, Reconstruction, Pavement Rehabilitation, Construction Management, Drainage and Misc. Improvements, to
 - College Avenue from Leroy Place to California Street,
 - El Camino Real from College Avenue to Bullock Avenue,
 - Francisco de Avondo from El Camino Real to California Street,
 - *Manzanares Street from California Street to Plaza Street.*

Within the control of the City of Socorro, in Socorro County, New Mexico.
